H 19658	Chair, Side	92cm H x 51cm W x 50cm D	Balloon-back Victorian side chair. Badly cracked areas in balloon-back frame. Old repairs made with metal. No known provenance.	1865-1885 (but the needlework on the back and seat most likely added in 1950s or 1960s.)
H 75819.001-.002	Chair, Side	100cm H x 50 cm W x 37cm D	Two side chairs with rush seat and urn shaped center splat. No known provenance. Piece of splat missing next to the chair rail on one.	1820-1850
X-WH05 00010	Chair, Side		Fancy-style mixed wood side chair. Missing the seat. No known provenance, but is similar to chairs made by Thomas Cole of Springfield, Ohio.	1825-1850

H 89188	Bin, Food Storage	77cmH x 295cm W x 55cm D	Large, rectangular food storage or grain bin made of wide boards of wood with a sloped top. Purchased in 2002 but no known provenance.	1900-1940
H 94832	Mattress	185cm H x 137cm W x 15.5cm D	Rectangular mattress covered with white and blue striped cotton ticking. "Genuine Nachman Body-Balance, Peerless."	1960s
X-WH01 0111	Mantle	107cm H x 120cm W x 23cm D	Black and gold cast iron mantle with indented panels on the sides. Top has a slight apron and an oxbow front. Arched door is missing. Remnants of gold decoration which have worn away. No known provenance.	1875-1900
